

After making his solo debut on COMEDIA at the beginning of June with his beautiful Tom Petty-influenced single Never Blue, Jan Json today releases the EP Need To Know. In addition to the aforementioned Never Blue, the EP also contains four more melodic rock songs that together form a beautifully suggestive whole.

Forty years ago, Jan Json was behind the drums in a Gothenburg band that in many places was given the epithet "Sweden's best live band". When the band disbanded after seven years on the road, he began writing and recording songs on his own with guitarist Magnus Hartelius, who like Jan Json is also known from the cult band Ensamma Hjärtan (Lonely Hearts) and its frontman Gunnar Danielsson's solo project. The collaboration of the two musician colleagues has continued over the years and the five songs on the EP Jeed To Kook are a result of the two musician colleagues' joint work.
